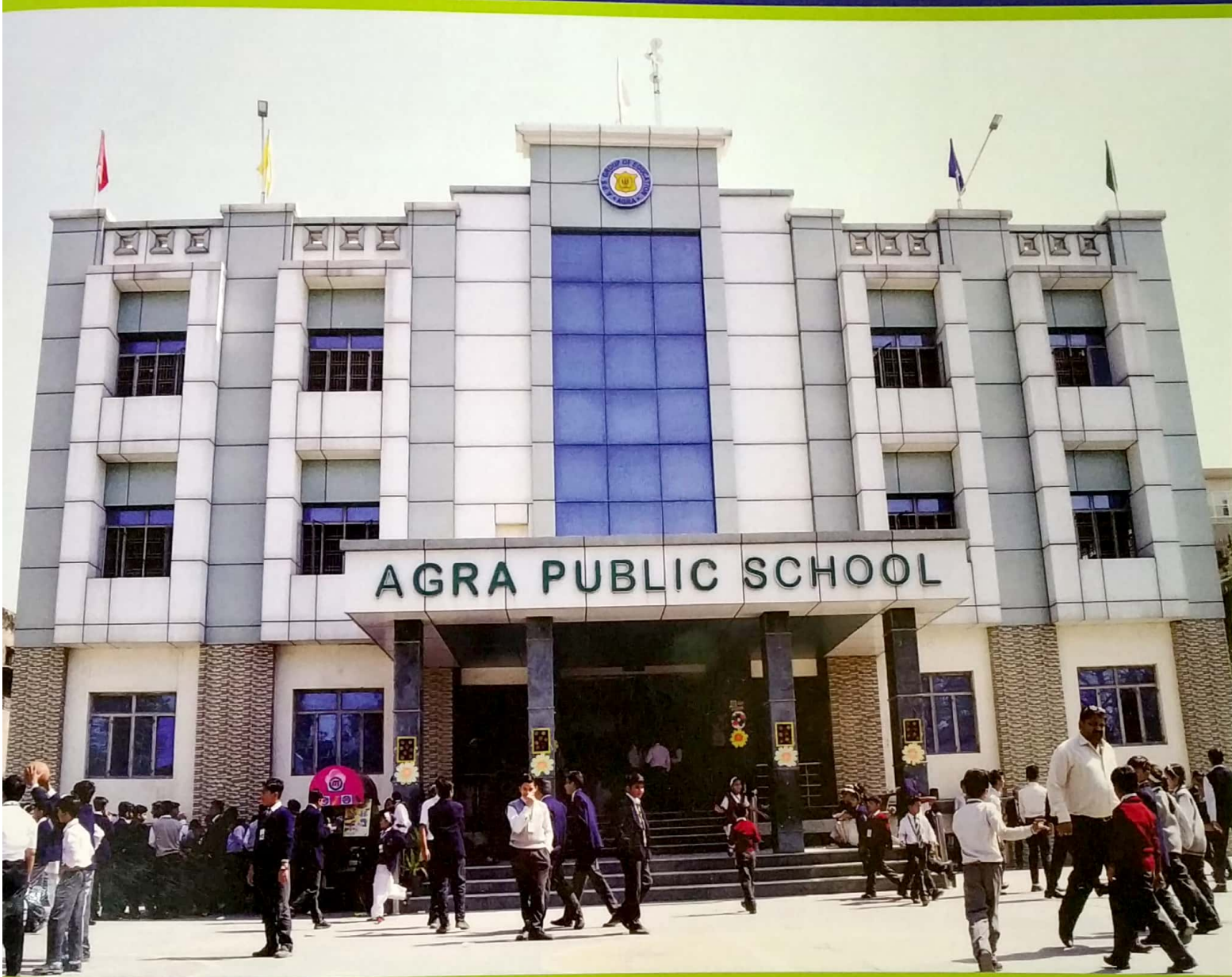

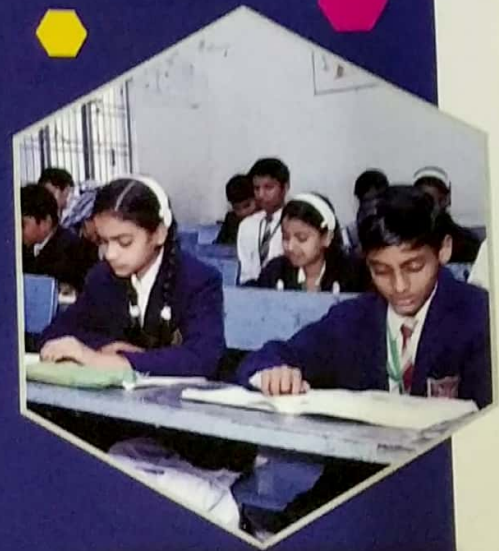

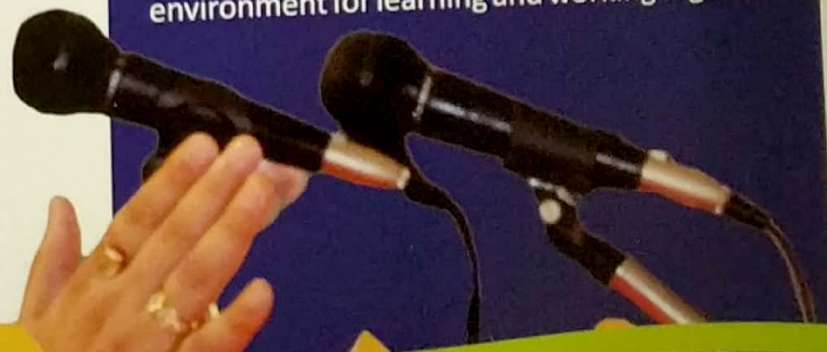

Our Mission



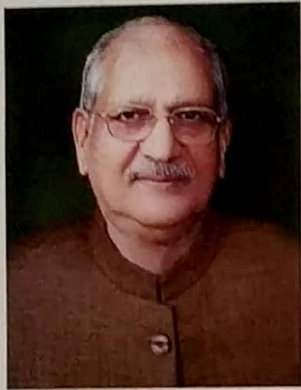

Procedure for Admission

- Student has to get registration form from the school office and submit it duly filled in with other relevant documents.
- He/She has to appear in the test and attend interview for admission.
- The age of the child for Pre-Nursery and Nursery should be 2-1/2 and 3+ respectively.
- Admitted students have to furnish the following documents at the time of admission.
- T. C. from a recognized school duly countersigned by the competent authority of Education Department.
- Parents of Nursery students have to submit Birth certificate of Nagar Mahapalika / Municipal Corporation.
- Registration for Pre Nursery class starts from January every year. They may be promoted to Nursery class in April on the basis of their exceptional performance.

Laboratories

Our students gain first-hand experience and gather information regarding laws of Physics, Chemistry and Biology in well equipped & furnished laboratories.

Physics Lab

A huge and spacious lab for physics is available here. It is equipped with various apparatus and science material for the use of about 60 students at a time. Practicals are regularly conducted under guidance of qualified Science Teachers.

Chemistry Lab

We have a spacious lab with maximum accommodation for sixty students at a time. It is enriched with ample of chemicals and different apparatus. Students are trained to handle glass wares properly and conduct experiments successfully.

Biology Lab

We have a large and huge Bio-Lab with lots of equipments electronic microscopes and computerized spots. Students are trained to measure B. P. and find out blood group etc.





Library & Reading Room

The library is the nerve centre of an institution. It provides materials to supplement and enrich instructions and guidance given in the class room. It exists to serve the objectives of its parent organization. Our library also aims at becoming a centre for educational excellence and references.

We bring a world of knowledge to the children through books written in English and Hindi on a wide range of subjects. Students are encouraged to learn and refer to these books for wider and deeper undertaking of subjects of interest. We also subscribe 40 periodicals for students and teachers. New volumes are added to it every year.

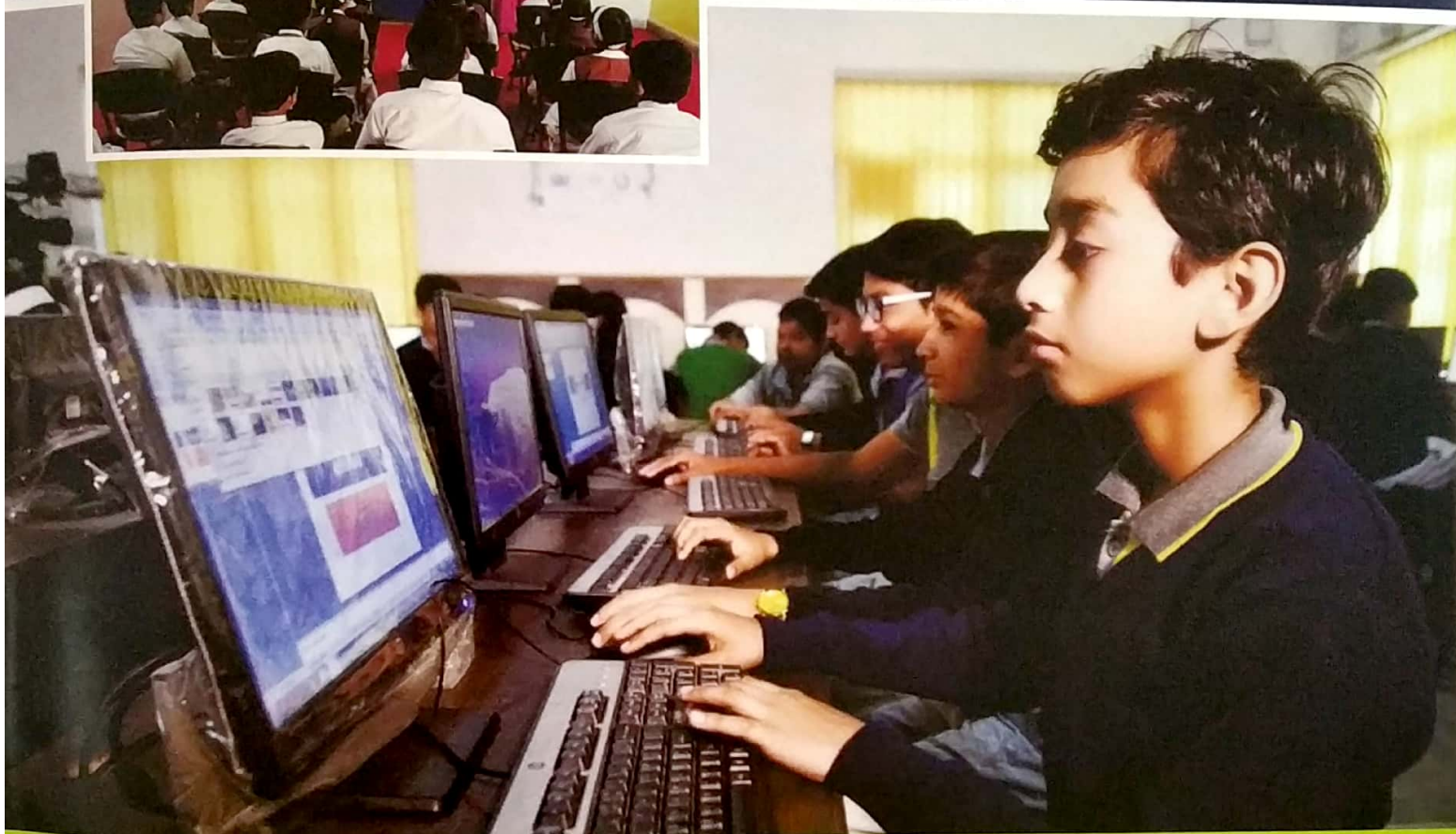


Smart Class

RULES & REGULATIONS

Attendance, Absence, Fine & Re-Admission Fee

1. As regular attendance is an important requirement for successful results, a previously written application for leave must be submitted well in advance. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances, the guardian should inform the Principal in writing as soon as possible. A minimum attendance of 90% of the total working days is required during the academic year falling short of which the student will not be allowed to take the examination.
2. The name of a student who is absent for 15 days without leave shall be struck off. On re-admission, a re-admission fee will be charged.
3. A student whose name has been struck off for absence without leave and who has been habitually late or persistently careless or indisciplined may not be re-admitted to the School.
4. Every student must be present on the reopening day after each vacation. It is advisable to ensure that a student is not disturbed during the examination days and is not asked to attend family functions.
6. No student can leave the school premises during school hours without written permission of the Principal, which may be granted under exceptional circumstances, based on written request of the parents.
7. The Principal has the right to suspend a student. The Principal may also ask the parents/guardians to withdraw their child from the School if his/her conduct or educational progress is not satisfactory.
8. All entries of absence, late-coming or half-day leave should be made in the diary and not on sheets of paper.

Classwork and Homework

1. Classwork, which includes oral work, written work and class tests, is taken into consideration for promotion.
2. Homework in English, Hindi, Maths and Science is given everyday. Guardians are requested to see that their children complete their homework regularly.

Parental Cooperation

1. Parents are required to look into their child's School Diary every day and see that the lessons and the homework assigned for the next day are done regularly by their wards.
2. Remarks made in the School Diary should be acknowledged and counter-signed regularly by the parents.
3. If you feel that your child is not making desired progress, please make it a point to discuss it with the Principal.
4. Criticism of a student's teacher or his school in the presence of the child should be avoided because it may cause the student to lose respect for his teacher and the School.
5. Parents are not allowed to meet their children or their teachers during school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
6. Parents are expected to participate regularly in school functions whenever they are invited.
7. Our school teachers do not take tuition of their own students. Therefore, do not force them to teach your wards privately.
8. Parents are requested to inform the School of any change of address.
9. Visitors are not allowed to meet the teachers in their respective classrooms.
10. a) Parents are required to send their children to school on time.
b) Presence of every child in the assembly is compulsory.
c) The child who fails to reach the School on time and does not attend the assembly, will be sent back home.
d) Parents should not take the child out of town without prior permission of the principal.
e) No sick child should be sent to school with medicines to be taken during school hours.
f) Children will not be allowed to go home from school in between school hours.
11. Please ensure that your ward takes part in all the activities of the School.
12. Parents are requested not to enter the School premises without the prior permission of the Principal. They are also requested not to call on their wards during class hours.

General Rules

1. Students of all classes should attend the Assembly in the morning. Late comers may not be admitted to class without the Principal's permission.
2. Parents or their servants are not allowed to enter any classroom. No servant is allowed to be in the school premises till home time.
3. No child is to be absent without a written leave application. In case of a contagious disease, the child will not be allowed to attend school without fitness certificate from an authorised medical practitioner.
4. No jewellery is to be worn except a wristwatch and no make-up of any kind is to be used. Nails are to be kept short.
5. The School does not accept responsibility for loss of books, money, clothes and so on. Each child is responsible for his/her own belongings.
6. Any kind of damage done to school property or premises by a student is to be made good by him/her. Students should keep their bicycles in the School cycle shed properly locked. School authorities will not be held responsible for any loss of unlocked cycles kept in the cycle shed.
7. Every child is urged to contribute to the high values of the School by his/her conduct, discipline and commitment to studies.
8. It is compulsory for students to participate in school functions, sports, cultural and literary activities. For at least one function per year the child will have to get a dress or costume made, as desired by the branch principal.
9. Immorality, grave insubordination, ragging, stealing or extortion of money or contempt of authority and breaking rules are always sufficient reasons for immediate expulsion and removal of a student from the school.
10. Parents' cooperation is solicited in maintaining punctuality, regularity and discipline in all school functions.

Library Rules

1. Books will be issued and returned as per rules framed by the concerned Branch.
2. Books will be issued for a definite period of time.
3. Only one book may be issued at a time.
4. A late fine will be charged daily until the book is returned.
5. The student should point out any damage to the books prior to getting them issued in his/her name; otherwise he/she will be charged for the damage.
6. tearing, writing, scribbling or folding the corners of the pages of books will be considered as damages done to the books.
7. Students losing books or damaging them will be asked to pay the cost of the books.
8. All the library books issued to the students must be returned before the commencement of the annual examination and clearance slips must be obtained from the library to appear in the examination.

Laboratory Rules

The School has well-equipped laboratories to facilitate experimental work in various sciences.

The following rules are to be observed in the laboratory:

1. Equipment for use in the laboratory will be issued to the students as per rules laid down by each branch.
2. No equipment is to be taken out of the laboratory without a written permission.
3. Any damage to the equipment during practical lessons will be borne by the students.
4. All the articles issued from the laboratories must be returned before the commencement of the annual examination and a clearance certificate obtained from the Science teachers to enable students to appear in the annual examination.

Change of Rules

Rules and Regulations mentioned in the prospectus may be changed without notice.

Any modification, as and when made, will be binding on all existing students.

School Examinations

1. progress of the students will be assessed on the basis of weekly, half-yearly and annual examinations. The marks obtained in these tests will be taken into consideration at the time of determining annual promotion.
2. Promotion is granted on the basis of a whole year's work. The Annual Examination is a means to reaffirm results of a full year's work; The decision of the school authorities with regards to promotion is final.
3. A student absent in any examination for any reason will not be re-examined.
4. All dues must be paid before the tests or exams; otherwise they will not be allowed to appear in the coming exam.
5. Final report card will be given to the guardians of the students only at the end of the academic session i.e. on the result day.

Parent-Teacher Meetings

Every branch periodically organises parent-teacher meetings in which talks are arranged on child education and child welfare. Attendance of at least one of the parents at such meetings is compulsory.
